Electrical and Electronic Equipment	 Accepted: waste from ship usual maintenance (electronical contates, computers, VHF, electronic cards,) Allowed: bulky waste (washing machines, stoves,), light bulbs and neons, cells and accumulators 	0,1 m3 / day
Aerosols	- Accepted: empty aerosols used (paint, solvents, degreaser,)	10 L / day

Batteries	- Accepted: start batteries of liferaft, backup batteries.	0,1 m3 / day
