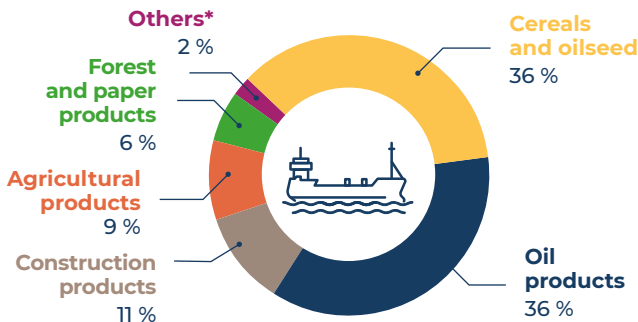


The **6** main sectors *of the Port*
