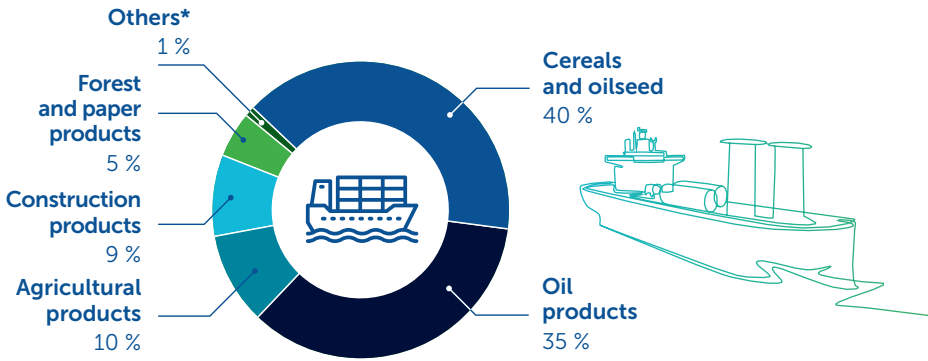


The 6 main sectors of the Port



* Metal products, heavy lift, containers, miscellaneous.

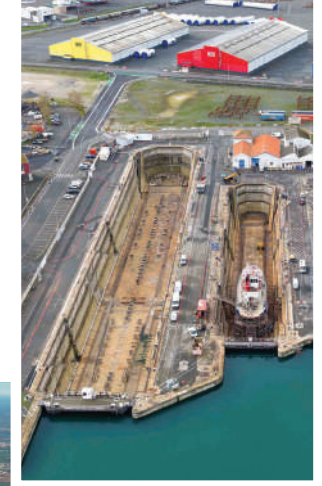
