









Admissible regulations for waste deposit MARPOL places

Type of waste	Comments	Max
<p>House Hold Waste</p> 	<p>- Accepted : non-hazardous waste from cooking, housemaintenance...</p> <p>- Allowed : bulky waste (furnitures, mattress, boxes), hazardous waste.</p>	0,3 m3 / day
<p>Recyclable Waste</p> 	<p>- Accepted : newspapers, cardboards, packing boxes, packing paper, plastic bottles and plastic flasks, punnets, canned food in aluminium.</p> <p>- Allowed : bulky waste (furnitures, pallets ...), food waste, hazardous waste.</p>	0,1 m3 / day
<p>Hazardous Waste</p> 	<p>- Accepted : waste from ship usual maintenance (empty paint can, oily rags, use filters, silicone cartridges,...)</p> <p>- Allowed : bulky waste and/or contents of liquid waste (barrel of 200L, solvents, waste oils, ...)</p>	0,1 m3 / day
<p>Electrical and Electronic Equipment</p> 	<p>- Accepted: waste from ship usual maintenance (electronical contatcs, computers, VHF, electronic cards,...)</p> <p>- Allowed: bulky waste (washing machines, stoves, ...), light bulbs and neons, cells and accumulators...</p>	0,1 m3 / day
<p>Aerosols</p> 	<p>- Accepted: empty aerosols used (paint, solvents, degreaser, ...)</p>	10 L / day

<p>Batteries</p> 	<p>- Accepted: start batteries of liferaft, backup batteries.</p>	<p>0,1 m3 / day</p>
<p>Cells and Accumulators</p> 	<p>- Accepted: coin batteries and accumulators (VHF, drill,...) -receptacle placed in batteries container</p>	<p>1 L/ day</p>
<p>Fluorescent Tubes and Lamps</p> 	<p>- Warning : theses lamps must be placed with precaution as they contains dangerous substances for health and environment . - Allowed : incandescent light bulb (in house hold waste)</p>	<p>10 units / day</p>
